Evenings following talks, practical presentations and competitions – the evening will be in two parts. In order to get best value from the services of the judge or speaker, the regular image clinic may include discussion about how to improve our images from the previous week's event, if members find this helpful. This will be followed by a refreshment break in the middle of the evening. To encourage all members' participation in club activities the session afterwards will be open to everyone for suggestions/leading, any subject of interest to members will be considered. This is an opportunity to either delve more deeply into a previous subject or broaden the scope of the programme.

Many thanks to the sub-Committee for their contribution to the programme. We would encourage you all to support their sessions which we hope will add extra dimension and interest to the club.

There are three competitions when normal submission dates fall on a Zoom event. These are Competition 3, the Art Portfolio and Image of the Year. This is due to availability of judges and speakers and could not be avoided. For these competitions a 3-week submission date is necessary.
