



## The Robin Hood Exhibition (NNPS) Privacy Policy

### Who we are:

The Robin Hood Exhibition (RHE) is managed by Nottingham and Notts Photographic Society (NNPS). NNPS stores basic data about entrants to the RHE.

- The Robin Hood Exhibition uses the 'PhotoExhib' Online entry system, developed and managed by BrightImaging (see separate Privacy Policy)
- Details of entrants will be stored and used solely for the purposes of administering this annual exhibition, including informing entrants of subsequent Robin Hood Exhibitions.
- Except as required for the management of exhibition data by NNPS and BrightImaging, no personal information will be transferred to any party outside of The Robin Hood Exhibition for any purpose, unless required by law or in compliance with the Terms and Conditions of the Robin Hood Exhibition, (for example, notifying the BPE).

### What we store:

NNPS only collect the minimum amount of personal data in order to operate the "The Robin Hood Exhibition". The information that we will be collecting from entrants will be as follows:

- Name, address and telephone number
- The photographic club of which you are a member
- Your email address
- Your Images and their Titles

### What we use the data for and where it is stored:

This data enables management of queries, production of the catalogue and RHE website updates. The data is stored within the NNPS website platform and is only accessed by relevant positional roles within NNPS for the management of the Exhibition.

### Data Retention:

Your data is held for a period of five years after the results are published for the most recent exhibition you entered (or actively registered for). However, your accepted images and full name are held until the RHE is terminally finished. This enables you to check previous entries and acceptances.
